Parkview RV Family Scholarship Application

ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 at the time of graduation.
- Must demonstrate a financial need.
- Must pursue a 2- or 4-year degree program at an accredited college/university or an accredited technical school.
- Must demonstrate good character and be active in community service.

GENERAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION:

- Financial assistance is accessible in July before the fall semester upon the submission of proof of enrollment (tuition bill and class schedule) to the CenDel Foundation.
- Additionally, this scholarship is renewable for up to three additional years, subject to the condition that the student maintains a 3.0 GPA and submits transcripts and proof of enrollment each summer before the commencement of the next academic year.

DEADLINES:

- Applications must be submitted on 2025 grant application and submitted by Friday, March 15, 2025 to be eligible for consideration for awards in the following academic year.
- 2025 Applications will be available at Milford High School's Guidance Department and online at www.cendelfoundation.org under the "Apply for a Grant" tab.

AWARDS:

• Applicants will receive notification of the award in the spring of 2025. (grant is not renewable).
